More than just a market, this pop-up celebrates sustainability and encourages more intentional purchasing within our community. Visitors will help to promote reuse of goods, reduce waste, and highlight the value of giving items a second life — on the grounds of Historic Rosedale which is a sprawling urban greenspace.
